

Members are being asked to vote on a possible change to the member/guest doubles eligibility.

The current rule reads:

Member/Guest Doubles:

Eligible teams consist of the following:

- Any SASBA member and another bowler of any age, unless they both have won a member/guest tournament, regardless of age and who their partner was. A listing of previous member and guest champions can be found on the SASBA web site.
- No two PBA Tour champs can bowl together.

The rule change would read:

One member/guest doubles tournament a year will be designated as the "Open Doubles Championship". This tournament will be open to any member and any guest with these exceptions:

1. No two PBA Tour champs can bowl together
2. No two who won a M/G Doubles as partners can bowl together.

For all other M/G Doubles...if a member won as a guest, but has not won a member/guest doubles as a member, he is eligible to bowl with anyone...whether they have won or not. If a member has won one member/guest doubles as a member, he can still bowl with anyone except the one he won with. Once he wins two member/guest doubles as a member, he can no longer bowl with a guest who has won a member/guest doubles.
