Jims Tip: On lanes with spotty heads and drying midlanes, it is sometimes difficult to get even a pearl ball to hit hard enough to carry. Unless you have an extremely high rev rate, you might want to consider a RICO drilling on a symmetrical pearl (3" pin). For average and lower rates, this layout can give you some continuation on dry midlanes and dry back ends. For most players, the breakpoint is fairly smooth as well. Most

pro shops are familiar with this layout, but contact me if you have questions about it.
