Jims Tips: Sometimes you can't create the ball shape your eyes are used to. The back ends are too dry or too tight. You've got over/ under with all of your balls. You can hit the pocket, but can't carry. Here's my tip(s) for when this occurs. 1. Don't have a pre-existing look in mind before you start practice. Just throw some shots, move around, switch balls and be open-minded. Take note of what knocks the pins down in-

stead of what you "want" to see. 2. Practice different hand positions regularly enough so that you aren't hesitant to try one or more in the tournament when nothing else is working. 3. Free up that armswing! Don't let taps or overreactions tighten your armswing or increase your grip pressure.
