#### Jim's Notes

Jim's Tips: More on shoe soles. Its hard to get good, consistent leverage if your foot has not come to a stop before the ball passes your ankle. If it's still moving, it could be more than your timing. Maybe you just need to change soles. Conversely, if your foot is stopping too soon, you'll again struggle with consistent releases and balance. Maybe you need a slide sock this week, because your #10 sole stops too quickly. In

either case, try to get to your starting lanes soon enough to test your slide and change your soles, if needed. This simple preparation could save you getting a check or making the finals.
