In the first stairstep game, the Genius team Jamie Brooks, Jim Stephens, Brad Hunter and Donald Robinson defeated the Masterminds team of A.C. Adam, Keith Lohse, Ken Johnson, Phil Hughes 222-203. They then lost to the Brawlers team of Ed Roberts, Harry Mikkelsen, Dick Baker, Ron

Mohr 246-211. The Danger Zones then beat them 235-223 to get into the title match.

One thing is for sure...if you didn't get it outside of the 10 board 45 feet

down the lane, it wasn't going to hit the pocket.
