Jims Tips: Are you using your practice shots in warm-ups wisely? I think it's smart to not only try to get lined up and loosened up, but throw different surfaces as well during practice. If you've got it set in your head that you're going to throw your new pearl ball no matter what, you could get locked in to a situation, where you don't match up. No carry, over/under, etc. when you go to the next pair. Throwing a pearl

surface with a long pin on heavy starting oil is rarely the best choice, yet I see lots of bowlers choosing to do that. At least, give the solids and particles a chance to shine during the warm-ups.
